# St Paul's working with Redbridge



So far this year we at St Paul's and the Lighthouse Church have contributed a lot of tinned food, packets of food, bottles of drink and cooking oils, jars of coffee, spreads, pickles and sauces, and toiletries for ladies, gents and children to the **Redbridge** 

**Foodbank**. Until a couple of months ago we were also contributing bedding and children's, ladies and gents clothing but the Foodbank no longer accepts these we will be giving them to RAMFEL who require them for the Refugees and Migrants within our Borough.

Our Harvest Festival this year, as in the past, divided our gifts and collection equally between the Foodbank and Mill Grove Children's Place. Our collection on that day raised £90, so each got £45. That together with monies collected over previous weeks for the Foodbank meant we were able to send them a cheque for £300 on the 3rd October. Many thanks to all those who have given so freely to help those people in our Borough who are living on the poverty line. Please continue to support this needed charity. Well done!

This year our **Redbridge Voluntary Care** Volunteers have been able to provide support to people in our Borough with transport for hospital, GP Surgeries and other Clinics as well as taking people to visit relatives/friends in hospital or Residential Homes. We have also provided visits, help in the home, prescriptions/pensions collection, shopping, help with mail and filling in forms, moving furniture downstairs for people no longer able to get upstairs. wheelchair pushing; escorting people to appointments etc..

In March this year we had our annual Quiz evening here at St Paul's and raised the grand sum of £900. Thanks go to those who helped and those of you who came to support us. Well done!





Over the past sixteen years we have appreciated and enjoyed help and support from many people to raise funds for feeding Street Children in Kenya, a project led and inspired by our branch of the Mothers' Union. During those years we have sent over £100,000 to our partner Anglican Diocese of Kirinyaga in Kenya, thereby providing almost a quarter of a million meals. This is an

ongoing project for which we require your help and support if we are to continue to provide the meals these children so urgently need. So far this year - without the proceeds of the Christmas Fair - we've raised £4.800.


