APCM/Electoral Roll

The Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) is taking place in church on Sunday 22 April at 11.15am. It is an opportunity to hear about the work of the parish during the last year - its activities, finances, charities, fabric and buildings - there will also be written reports from groups covering the varied areas within the church. It is also the time when the Church Wardens and new PCC members will be elected.

An APCM booklet will be available electronically nearer the time but if you want a paper copy please sign the sheet at the back of the church.

In order to be able to vote at the APCM you must be on the Electoral Roll. If you are already on the Roll there is no need to re-apply. To be eligible you must either live in the parish or have worshipped at St. Paul's Church for at least six months. For a form please see Rosemary Monks or Ola Franklin. Your name must be on the Electoral Roll by 7 April.

APCM - 22 April

Following retirements from the PCC, there will be three vacancies to be filled on the PCC at the APCM. There will also be the usual election of two churchwardens.

If you are interested in any of these positions, please speak to the Ministry team or churchwardens to find out what is involved. Nomination forms can be obtained from John Wooden.
