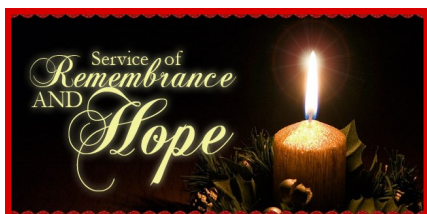


## **10:00 PARISH COMMUNION**
